STEP 1

Please submit the following:

- professional headshot (white background)
- tuberculosis (TB) blood test results/ TB screening form
- immunization records
- TELP Volunteer Agreement document

STEP 2

After submitting these materials, you'll receive a link to YouScience. This tool will help us match your rotations with your strengths and career goals.

STEP 3

Upon completing the YouScience aptitude assessment, you'll get a link to schedule your applicant screening.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Applications are reviewed upon submission until positions are filled or the deadline nears.

Interviews are conducted on a rolling basis.

Applications close on Monday, March 17, 2025.
Apply early, as spots fill quickly.

Decisions will be emailed on Tuesday, April 1, 2025.

Your application is considered complete only after all necessary materials are received by the Office of Health Equity and you have received a link to submit additional documentation.

Shirt
