Qualifications: Successful completion of an ACGME or AOA accredited post-graduate training program in Emergency Medicine, Family Medicine, Pediatrics, Surgery, or General/Internal Medicine, and;

Current certification or active participation in the examination process leading to certification in Emergency Medicine by the American Board of Emergency Medicine or an equivalent to be achieved within three (3) years of becoming eligible.

Special Procedures: Successful completion of an approved, recognized course when such exists, or acceptable supervised training in residency, fellowship or other acceptable experience, and documentation of competence to obtain and retain clinical privileges as set forth in medical staff policies governing the exercise of specific privileges.

References: A letter of reference must come from the director of the applicant's specialty training program or from the Chair/Chief of the specialty at the institution where the applicant was most recently affiliated.

Current Continuing Education: Submission of at least 40 hours of continuing medical education every 2 years or the number of hours required by the Georgia State Medical Board.

Reappointment Requirements: Applicants must be able to demonstrate that they have maintained competence by showing evidence that they have provided emergency medicine services during the course of at least 40, 8-hour shifts in the past 24 months.
